

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING  
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2022**

At 9:01 a.m. Chairperson Bob Yoder called to order in regular session a meeting of the Washington County Board of Supervisors which took place in the Washington County Courthouse. Items on the agenda included approval of agenda; public comment; Sockum Ridge Recreation Area Timber Project; personnel change request – Treasurer; disposition of decommissioned Washington County Ambulance; department head comment; adjourn. Supervisors Marcus Fedler, Jack Seward, Jr., Richard Young, and Stan Stoops were also in attendance.

Other individuals present at the meeting included Jennifer Wilkerson, KCII Radio; Kalen McCain, SE Iowa Union; Jeff Garrett, County Treasurer; Anthony Janney, Acting County Attorney; Katrina Altenhofen, Interim County Ambulance Services Director; and Zach Rozmus, County Conservation Director. Various other individuals listened and/or watched remotely by way of electronic means.

All motions were passed unanimously by those Supervisors in attendance unless noted otherwise.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Fedler, the Board voted to approve the agenda.

There was no public comment.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Stoops, the Board voted to acknowledge the Sockum Ridge Recreation Area Timber Project. The project involves the selective removal of trees that compromise the growth and development of other healthier and more mature trees.

On motion by Young, seconded by Fedler, the Board voted to acknowledge, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, a personnel change request from the Treasurer's Office for non-exempt full-time Clerk Amy Greiner whose rate of pay will increase to \$20.89 per hour effective February 23, 2023.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Fedler, the Board voted to authorize the Interim Washington County Ambulance Director to take the steps necessary to sell a 1996 Ford ambulance.

There was no department head comment.

At 9:20 a.m. on motion by Fedler, seconded by Young, the Board voted to adjourn.
