

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
TUESDAY, JUNE 7, 2022**

At 9:00 a.m. Chairperson Richard Young called to order in regular session a meeting of the Washington County Board of Supervisors which took place in the Washington County Courthouse. Items on the agenda included the following: approval of agenda; public comment; appointment of Ethan Hansen as Deputy Sheriff; renewal of Tobacco Permit for Ainsworth Four Corners DBA Four Corners Fuel; personnel change requests – Sheriff; personnel change request – Washington County Ambulance Services; department head comment; adjourn. Supervisors Marcus Fedler, Jack Seward, Jr., Bob Yoder, and Stan Stoops were also present.

Other individuals in attendance included: Jerry Edwards, KCII Radio; Kalen McCain, SE Iowa Union; and Amber Williams, Board of Supervisors Administrative Assistant. Various other individuals participated remotely.

All motions were passed unanimously by those Supervisors in attendance unless noted otherwise.

On motion by Yoder, seconded by Fedler, the Board voted to approve the agenda as published.

There was no public comment related to agenda items.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Seward, the Board voted to approve the appointment of Ethan Hansen to the position of Deputy Sheriff beginning on May 27, 2022, and ending on December 31, 2024.

On motion by Fedler, seconded by Seward, the Board voted to approve, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, an application from Four Corners Fuel Stop D/B/A as Four Corners Fuel, Ainsworth, for an Iowa Retail Sales Permit for the sale of Cigarette/Tobacco/Nicotine/Vapor products for the period of July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023. Sheriff Jared Schneider expressed no issues with the application.

On motion by Yoder, seconded by Fedler, the Board voted to acknowledge, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, a personnel change request from the Office of Sheriff for Tyler Kleese whose final day of employment occurred on June 1, 2022.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Yoder, the Board voted to acknowledge, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, a personnel change request from the Office of Sheriff involving a change in pay rate to \$27.16 per hour for Derek Glaspie effective June 2, 2022. The change corresponds to Glaspie becoming a Washington County Civil Deputy.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Seward, the Board voted to acknowledge, and authorize the Chairperson to sign, a personnel change request from Washington County Ambulance Services for Kimberly Browning whose final day of employment occurred on May 31, 2022.

There was no comment from department heads.

At 9:12 a.m. on motion by Yoder, seconded by Fedler, the Board voted to adjourn.
