

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING  
MONDAY, AUGUST 21, 2023**

At 10:00 a.m. Chairperson Bob Yoder called to order in regular session a meeting of the Washington County Board of Supervisors that took place in the Washington County Courthouse. Items on the agenda included recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance; approval of agenda; public comment related to agenda items; discussion and action on proposed settlement and purchase agreement with L&L Acres LLC; department comment; adjourn. Supervisors Jack Seward Jr., Richard Young, Marcus Fedler, and Stan Stoops were also present.

Other individuals present at the meeting included Kalen McCain with the SE Iowa Union along with Board of Supervisors Administrative Assistant Amber Williams; County Engineer Jacob Thorius, and Washington County Attorney Nathan Repp. Various other individuals listened and/or watched remotely by way of electronic means.

All motions were passed unanimously unless noted otherwise.

Seward led those individuals assembled in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

There was no public comment.

On motion by Stoops, seconded by Young, the Board voted to approve the agenda as published.

On motion by Seward, seconded by Fedler, the Board voted to accept and approve a proposed settlement agreement with L&L Acres LLC. The accepted and approved agreement is related to the purchase of various permanent easement rights by Washington County (Buyer) from L&L Acres LLC (Seller). The agreement also addresses Buyer's responsibility for Seller's driveway maintenance expenses and for damage to Seller's remaining land.

There was no public comment.
